**ORDINANCE 2018-25**

**An Ordinance Establishing the Hourly Position of Computer Operator Trainee (01332)**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Town of Kearny, in the County of Hudson, as follows:

**SECTION 1. Establishment**

The position of “Computer Operator Trainee” (01332) be and hereby is established as a part-time position in and for the Town of Kearny.

**SECTION 2. Salary**

Ordinance 2016-33 entitled “An Ordinance to Further Amend and Supplement an Ordinance Entitled ‘An Ordinance Concerning Civil Service in the Town of Kearny, County of Hudson’, adopted March 24, 2014 and All Various Civil Service Titles in the Town of Kearny (Civil Service Council 11 Salaries for 2015, 2016, 2017, and 2018)” adopted August 9, 2016, be and hereby is amended and supplemented to provide for the compensation rates as follows:

**Computer Operator Trainee  
2018**

The salary for the Computer Operator Trainee for the year 2018 shall be within the range of \$12.00 to \$16.00 per hour.

**SECTION 3. Repealer**

All Ordinances and parts thereof conflicting herewith be, and the same hereby are, repealed.

**SECTION 4. Severability**

If any section, paragraph subdivision, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be adjudged invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to that section, paragraph, subdivision, clause or provision so adjudged, and the remainder of this Ordinance shall be deemed to be valid and effective.

**SECTION 5. Effective Date**

This Ordinance shall be effective upon passage and publication as required by law.
